

Navarre Beach >

Navarre Beach is one of those places that you can't help but love.

Its uncrowded shores, soft sands and emerald waves have a soothing effect on your soul. Make yourself at home, and enjoy the sand, sun and surf.

Navarre's White Quartz Sand

Tens of thousands of years ago, Navarre Beach was formed by minerals from the Appalachian Mountains. As centuries passed, all other minerals were worn down to dust and washed away, but resilient Quartz remained. Today, Navarre Beach is composed of White Quartz Sand, some of the most pristine sand in the world.

Gulf Islands National Seashore

National Seashore One of only ten National Seashores in the United States, the Gulf Islands National Seashore offers eight miles of undeveloped beachfront. See towering dunes, iridescent shells, nesting sea turtles, migratory birds and trails through this unique Gulf of Mexico habitat.



Home is where your nest is.

Navarre Beach isn't just welcoming to humans—it's home to many nesting sea turtles. In fact, the Navarre Beach Sea Turtle Conservation Center is located in the Navarre Beach Marine Park.

Save the Sea Turtles

If you see a turtle nest, be careful to not disturb it! If you dig anywhere or create holes in the sand, be sure to fill them in, and never leave trash or debris on the beach. Only leave your footprints and let these baby turtles rest up so they have the energy to hatch and make it to the ocean. Learn more about sea turtles and conservation at GetRelaxing.com.

The Navarre Beach Pier

Take a long walk on a long pier when you visit the longest fishing pier in Florida. At 1545 ft. long and 30 ft. above the water, the Navarre Beach Pier is an excellent choice for fishing, people-watching or just watching the emerald waves roll in.



Navarre Beach Marine Park

This park connects three attractions above and below sea level: Navarre Beach Marine Science Station, Navarre Beach Sea Turtle Conservation Center, and the Navarre Beach Marine Sanctuary and Artificial Reefs. The Marine Science Station is typically a closed classroom, but does open to the public for events.





See the sunrise and sunset from the same spot.

For early risers, Navarre's beaches are the perfect place for watching a beautiful sunrise show. And for those not-so-early risers, you can catch the evening encore performance at sunset. Because we're parallel with the path of the sun, you'll always have the best seat in the house on our beaches.

While the town was being developed, the area was known by multiple names, including "Jernigan's Landing," "Hard Scrabble" and "Scratch Ankle" before being named Milton.



Old Brick Road

Follow the Old Red Brick Road in Milton! Sometimes known as Old Spanish Trail, the Red Brick Road was originally built in 1921 and the Milton portion is 6 miles long and 9 feet wide.

Coldwater Creek

Splash into the brisk waters of Coldwater Creek in Blackwater River State Forest. Perfect for paddling or tubing, this spring-fed river remains at 72° year-round and is naturally dark with tannins, making it a scenic adventure getaway.





Trek the Trails

Get away from traffic and go at your own speed on our hiking and riding trails. We have over 35 trails along rivers, pinewoods, cypress and more for your traveling pleasure. Try the 11-mile paved Blackwater Heritage Trail along a historic rail line, the popular 7.3-mile Juniper Creek Trail along gorgeous Juniper Creek or the very first trail built in Blackwater River State Forest in the 1970s—the Florida Trail. Our scenic trails are a great way to exercise and explore.



The Nation's First Tree Farm

Naval Live Oaks Preserve was established in 1828 as the nation's first tree farm. At the time, our country's navy built ships out of sturdy Live Oaks, and President John Quincy Adams recognized the beautiful abundance of them on Navarre Beach, conveniently located near the Pensacola Coastal.
