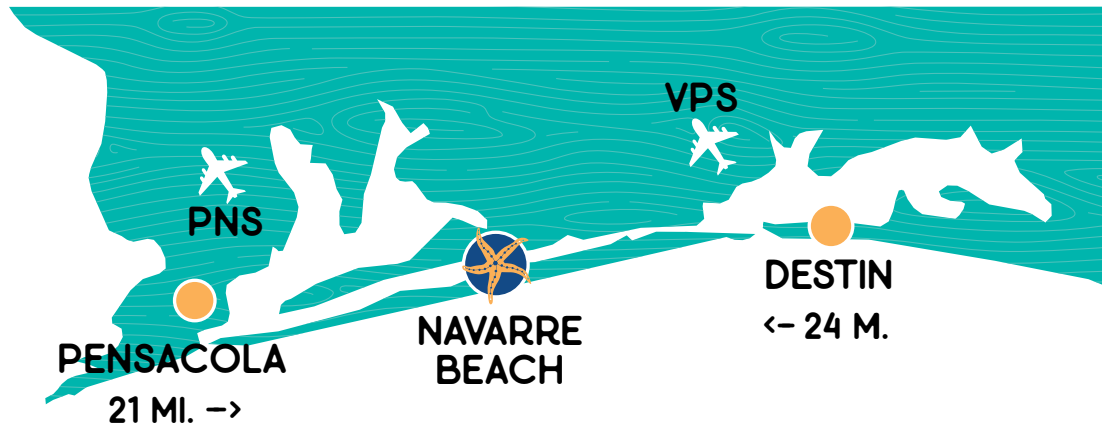

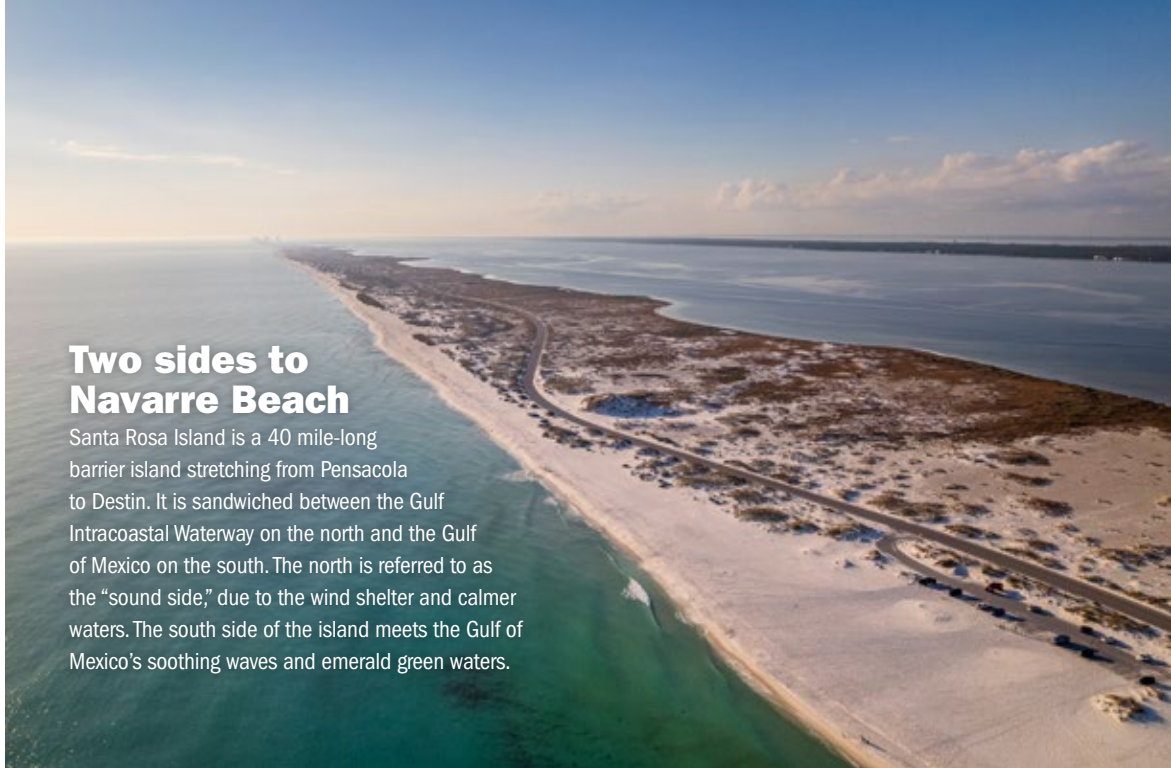
Gulf Islands National Seashore

Two sides to Navarre Beach

Santa Rosa Island is a 40 mile-long barrier island stretching from Pensacola to Destin. It is sandwiched between the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway on the north and the Gulf of Mexico on the south. The north is referred to as the “sound side,” due to the wind shelter and calmer waters. The south side of the island meets the Gulf of Mexico’s soothing waves and emerald green waters.





Home is where your nest is.

Navarre Beach isn't just welcoming to humans—it's home to many nesting sea turtles. In fact, the **Navarre Beach Sea Turtle Conservation Center (NBSTCC)**, located in the **Navarre Beach Marine Park**, is dedicated to giving sea turtles more tomorrows through conservation, education and research. Come see Sweet Pea the sea turtle, and a wide variety of sea creatures from the Gulf of Mexico.

Save the Sea Turtles

If you see a turtle nest, be careful to not disturb it! If you dig anywhere or create holes in the sand, be sure to fill them in, and never leave trash or debris on the beach—only leave your footprints. Let these baby turtles rest up so they have the energy to hatch and make it to the Gulf of Mexico. Learn more about sea turtles and conservation at GetRelaxing.com.

Navarre Beach Marine Park

This park connects three attractions above and below sea level: Navarre Beach Marine Science Station, Navarre Beach Sea Turtle Conservation Center, and the Navarre Beach Marine Sanctuary and Artificial Reefs. The Marine Science Station is typically a closed classroom, but does open to the public for special events.

Navarre's White Quartz Sand

Tens of thousands of years ago, Navarre Beach was formed by minerals from the Appalachian Mountains. As centuries passed, all other minerals were worn down to dust and washed away, but resilient quartz remained. Today, Navarre Beach is composed of white quartz sand, some of the most pristine sand in the world.

For those who love snorkeling or diving, check out our beautiful marine life at the “nearshore” artificial reefs of Navarre: East Sound Side Reef, West Sound Side Reef and Gulf Side Reef. The areas are all marked off to prevent motorized vessels, so you’re free to swim and explore the beautiful coral, turtles, urchins, jellyfish, stingray, octopuses, colorful fish and more!

Did you know Milton was once called “Scratch Ankle”?

While the town was being developed, the area was known by multiple names, including “Jernigan’s Landing,” “Hard Scrabble” and “Scratch Ankle” before being named Milton.



Old Brick Road

Follow the Old Red Brick Road in Milton! Sometimes known as Old Spanish Trail, the Red Brick Road was originally built in 1921 and the Milton portion is 6 miles long and 9 feet wide.



West Florida Railroad Museum

With the first trains running all the way back in 1882, the L&N Railroad Depot has a considerable amount of history surrounding it—so much that they turned the old depot into a museum! Examine historic photographs and classic train cars from the depot's many years of service when you come enjoy this piece of local history.

Trek the Trails

Get away from traffic and go at your own speed on our hiking and riding trails. We have over 35 trails along rivers, pinewoods, cypress and more for your traveling pleasure. Try the 8.1-mile paved Blackwater Heritage Trail along a historic rail line, the popular 7.3-mile Juniper Creek Trail along gorgeous Juniper Creek, or the very first trail built in Blackwater River State Forest in the 1970s—the Florida Trail. Our scenic trails are a great way to exercise and explore.



The Nation's First Tree Farm

Naval Live Oaks Nature Preserve was established in 1828 as the nation's first tree farm. At the time, our country's navy built ships out of sturdy Live Oaks, and President John Quincy Adams recognized the beautiful abundance of them in Santa Rosa County. To this day, the land is still protected and is the nation's first and oldest tree farm.

Coldwater Creek

Splash into the brisk waters of Coldwater Creek in North County. Perfect for paddling or tubing, this spring-fed river remains at 72 degrees year-round and is naturally dark with tannins, making it a scenic adventure getaway.





Blackwater River State Park

Stroll through more than 600 acres of undisturbed nature when you visit the Blackwater River State Park. Since 1980, it has been recognized and certified as a Registered State Natural Feature for its exceptional illustration of Florida's natural history. With places to camp and canoe, it's truly an amazing experience to adventure through Blackwater River State Park.

What's in a Name?

The Blackwater River's sandy bottom, white beaches and sandbars contrast with the dark tannic water that gives the river its name. "Blackwater" is a translation of the Choctaw word oka-lusa, which means "water black."

Attention treasure seekers: Blackwater River State Park is a hot-spot for geocaching! Discover multiple caches on a high-tech treasure hunt with your handheld global positioning systems (GPS) devices for an adventure like none other.

Blackwater River State Forest

When visiting Blackwater River State Forest, there are two things you need: a sense of adventure and a love of exploration. To get your blood pumping, there are plenty of trails for hiking and biking. To cool down, check out the creeks and rivers where you'll uncover excellent spots for kayaking, tubing and swimming. Whether you want to explore the forest or just chill at a campsite, you'll love hanging out in the Blackwater River State Forest.

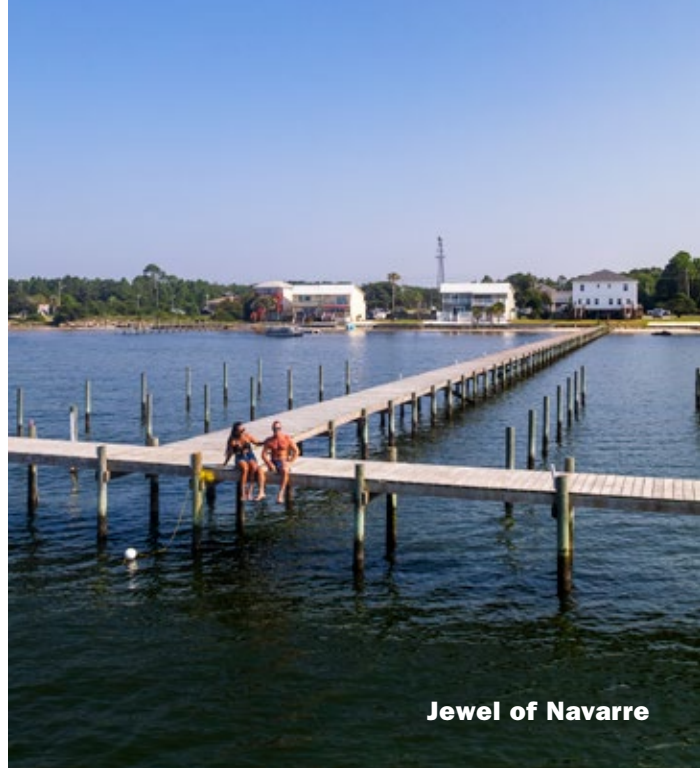
